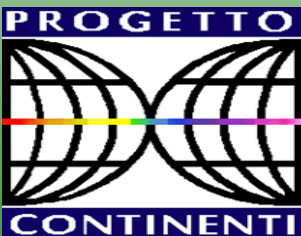




**Sangkheum Center for Children
Annual Report
September 2009-August 2010**



**Bringing Hope to a
young Generation**



Since 2001, Sangkheum Center for Children have supported orphaned, abandoned and underprivileged children and youth through care, scholastic support and training. We provide them with the necessary tools to create a brighter future for themselves and integrate them back into their community as responsible young adults. We work with more than 400 children and youth on a daily basis, bringing hope to the young generation of Cambodia.



Beneficiaries :

1. 57 Resident children
2. 105 Non-resident children
3. 310 children from communities surrounding Sangkheum Center
4. 16 young adult preparation program.

- **Resident Children**

57 resident children between the ages of 2-16 are under full time care, receiving full time support through housing, medical support, food, hygiene, education, love and care.

In this year we initiated a foster care program for a HIV infected baby who was abandoned in Angkor Hospital for Children. When children reach 16 years old they are transferred to the Young





2. Non resident Children

105 children, 42 girls and 63 boys, from 56 families in 7 different communes are supported as non resident children. The children aging from 6-17 years old.

- 105 Children received a school package for the first semester
- 65 children whose home away from school received a bicycle.
- 953 monitoring school and home visits have been conducted
- 34 children have been supported with transportation to hospitals and monitoring of health conditions

School package : 2 set uniforms, 1 school back, note books, pens, pencils, rulers.....

3. Children from communities surrounding Sangkheum Center:

310 children from surrounding communities have received:

- 2580(70 per week) English language lessons.
- 610 (16 per week) Recreational activity classes
- 85 bicycles delivered to children with long distance to school.
- 56 children have been supported with school package



4. Young Adult Program

When children in Sangkheum Center reach 16 years old they start to attend young adults preparation program. The aim is that all young adults leave the Sangkheum Center for Children at age 18 with necessary education, skills, work prospects to ensure their successful integration into the communities.



- 13 resident Young Adults 9 males and 4 females, ages of 16 to 18 participated in the Young Adult Program.
- 2 attended skill training of a cook and front office.
- 11 attended English language at Private School in Siem Reap.
- 4 boys graduated (Finish high school) and will continue university. 3 of them get part time job. The other one going to finish skill training soon.



Integration Program

- 7 young adults participate in the Integration Program.

5 young adults were integrated to their families with full time employment.

- 2 young adults are in a scholarship program aiming at university studies.
- 2 of them graduated (Finished High school)

Sport program

The sport program has delivered regular football training and games with other teams to resident, non resident and additional children from surrounding areas.

- 158 (5 per week) football trainings have been delivered to 37 boys and 45 girls
- 15 football games have been played with other teams.
- 2 teams participate in a 10 weeks football league in Siem Reap.
- The boy team U14 top score was the winner for the Junior Soccer League Siem Reap.
- The boy team U 12 result was a runner-up in between 24 different teams played again ISF (Indochina Starfish Foundation) Football Tournament in Phnom Penh.



Staff capacity building and Social work

Staff Capacity Building

- Have trained about how to work with the vulnerable Children
- Awareness of Child Protection Policy
- Trained about the Care and work with HIV/AIDS Children



- Traffic law training (safety on the road)

314 children aware of traffic signs, theories and practicing on the road.

- 350 children attended summer school program for 3 weeks, They have learnt of personal hygiene and concept of environment courses.
- They have gone 4 days to collect rubbishes a long the street in Siem Reap city. These activities we cooperated with local authorities in each area.
